Communal Areas

All the communal areas of Alsley Lodge are bright, spacious, spotlessly clean and attractively decorated. A maintenance person is employed to keep the home in perfect order. The home is suitably designed for easy wheelchair use. There are no stairs as the home is single storey, all doors are extra wide and our off street parking and garden have level access to the home. The two assisted bathrooms, all the en suite bathrooms and the corridors are fitted with handrails.

With the aid of sections of the NHS, problems are solved. Sadly she has suffered a relapse but every member of staff without exemption has rallied around and made every effort to get her back on track. Health


The prime objective of our home is to promote and foster health and wellbeing. On admission of each resident, an assessment of need is performed by a senior member of the care team, from which a Care Plan is created. Residents, their relatives and doctors are offered and encouraged to participate in the drafting and continuous review of their Care Plan. A review is conducted monthly, unless changes in the resident's condition necessitate more frequent reviews.

When a new resident join the home, we work with the resident's GP to ensure that we have a full understanding of their health and well-being. The District Nurse Team work alongside the GP and can be called on when necessary.

In case of illness, relatives are informed immediately and are updated regularly on the patient's recovery. If family members wish to be present whilst their relative is ill, we arrange suitable accommodation for them. Residents using the home for convalescent purposes are attended by a rehabilitation team to prepare them to be discharged back home.

My mother-in-law has only been in Ashley lodge for two weeks. She is now looking at long-term care and I'm so glad we picked Ashley Lodge. It's a lovely friendly place, staff are always happy which in turn makes residents look happy. The difference in my mother-in-law in the short space of time is giving us as a family peace of mind knowing she's been well cared for at 88 years young. She's looking happier and laughing with staff and residents which we haven't seen in almost 5years of living at home alone after losing my beautiful father-in-law who she misses so much. But now unable to be cared for at home I couldn't have picked a nicer caring team. We visit any time of the day and always welcome I couldn't be more happier and all the family feel the same. Thank you for taking care of my mother-in-law in the lovely way you are and hopefully, she's as happy as she looks each day. Thank you all.

We also have our own on-site hair salon and hairdresser.

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Your Family

Alsley Lodge is not just a home, but a family too. Everyone is made to feel welcome and cared for, and we value each resident's individuality. - The laundry facility is well equipped and well organised
- Well behaved pets are allowed in the rooms
- Every room has a locked cabinet and residents can insure their possessions if they wish.



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I previously looked after my mum in her own home but this became increasingly difficult due to progressing dementia. I looked at several care homes before I found Alsley Lodge Care Home. We needed respite for a family holiday, which we were fortunate to book at relatively short notice. Her room is modern and fresh with an en-suite wet room. She enjoys getting her hair done every week, she doesn't participate in many activities but there are a variety of things on offer.
